Project Overview: wfyi.org Site Migration

WFYI Public Media's website, wfyi.org, is hosted on a LAMP environment composed of Ubuntu 14.04.5 LTS, Apache 2.4.x, MySQL 5.6.x, and PHP 5.6.x. We would like to upgrade the Linux, MySQL and PHP components to the latest versions. To ensure compatibility with the website CMS we need to complete functionality testing. WFYI proposes that a team will create a virtual machine image test the platform of wfyi.org. Installation/setup documentation will also be created to allow IT staff to re-create the environment represented by the virtual machine in a remote hosting environment (DigitalOcean).

Linux (Ubuntu server) 16.04.3 LTS
