What is SNAP?

Supplemental Nutrition Assistance Program (SNAP) a federal program that helps millions of low-income Americans put food on the table. Across the United States there are 9.5 million families with children on SNAP. It is the largest program working to fight hunger in America.


Why is SNAP Important SNAP provides families with their basic nutritional needs to get them through temporary hard times. It helps people get back on their feet and on the road to a better life — in 2015, SNAP lifted 4.6 million

Who is eligible to receive SNAP snaP is targeted toward our most at-risk citizens, predominantly serving households with children, elderly or disabled members.

 create and publish a SNAP calculator for the state of Indiana to ILS Website.
