- Brought education about that time in history to places around the world, but specifically in Indiana



Our End Goal for the Semester

- Make a virtual garden that lives on a WFYI website that allows users to create and plant flowers with a message about how Eva's story has affected them and their lives
 - Make it so other people's flowers are visible to users
- Sharing capability to spread the word about Eva's story and this garden project
- Roll this out along with the 75th anniversary of the liberation from Auschwitz

Future Recommendations

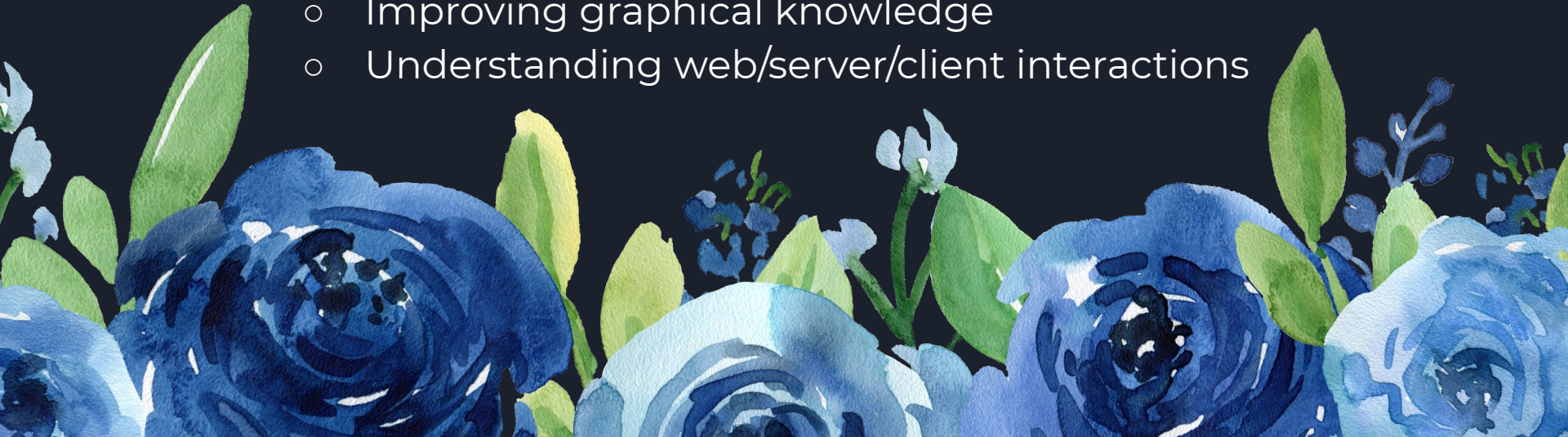
- Fix scaling issues on the HTML form
